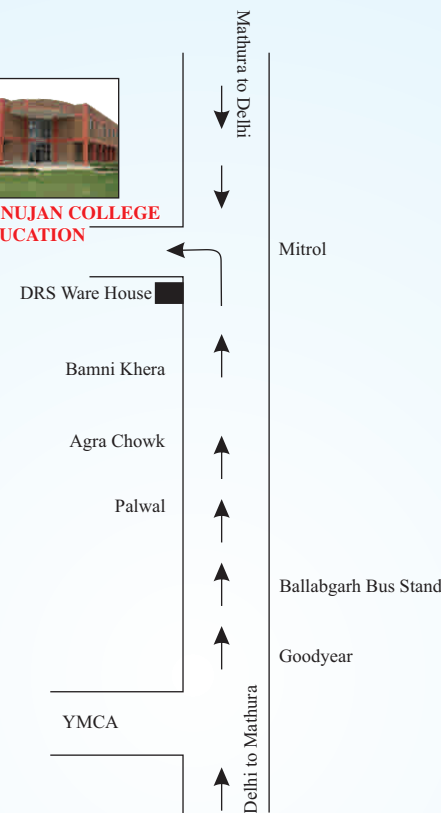

General Rules:

- Decision of Organizing Committee shall be final and binding on all participants/contestants
- Rules may be modified to enhance objectivity, transparency and merit
- Entry is restricted to participants/contestants only.
- Participants must carry their Identity Cards & introduction letters from their school/college Principals/Deans.
- Participation can be cancelled /disallowed in the event of any indiscipline and/or unethical behavior by a participant /contestant
- Eligibility: Must be a P.G. student/ pupil-Teacher or Staff of any recognized institution. Preferred Age: Below 35 Yrs.
- Individual Entries, Maximum Five participants per school/ college/ institution
- Medium can be either Hindi or English
- Token Registration Fee Rs. 75/- per participant for school teachers/College teacher and Rs 50/-for pupil teachers
- Last date of Registration is 08.March. 2010
- Free bus transport facility is available for participants /contestants from Old Faridabad to College Campus and back. College bus will leave Old Faridabad at 7:30 am and will cross Palwal at 8:00am. Please Contact : 0989005329, 9950221626
- Participants / Contestants should collect free refreshment coupon during lunch break
- The participant must provide the prescribed form duly filled and forwarded by the College/School authority
- Programmes 1-5 are mandatory to qualify for the Art of Quality Teaching contest whereas Programme 6 is optional.
- At least five Participants are necessary for any competition(except Drama)otherwise, the competition will be merged or cancelled.

CATEGORY OF AWARDS :

- Best Performers, obtaining highest points/marks in all categories of competition except drama will be awarded with cash awards of Rs.21,000=00
- Cash Award of Rs. 1100/- , memento & certificate will be given to winner i.e. first position holder in each category of competition
- Mementos & Certificates will be given to second and third position holders in each category
- Certificate of participant will be issued to remaining participants when found necessary.

ELOQUENCE COMPETITION

Objectives:

1. To know the content knowledge of the participants
2. To know the sharpness of mind to arrange & present in contest.
3. To know the figurative use of language.
4. To punctuate subject matter of the objective of content properly.



Procedures:

1. Participants are allowed for either Hindi or English as medium
2. Time for eloquence is 5 + 1 minutes.
3. Following are the judgment points
 - Address & Introduction
 - Content & its Presentation
 - Figurative Language & Grammar
 - Conclusion and time adjustments
4. Topics will be declared before 24 hours of the competition on College website

CONTENT PRESENTATION THROUGH TEACHING AIDS COMPETITION

Objectives:

1. To know effectiveness of teaching
2. To use innovative ideas
3. To know the research , creativity and reproductive thinking
4. To know the imagination and memory power
5. To know the use of skills teaching



Procedures:

1. Topic will be of participant choice & must contain school object
2. Medium of participant will be either Hindi or English
3. Time for presenting the content is 5+1 minutes.
4. The participant is required to use his own teaching Aids & B.B. cloth etc.
5. Judgments points of his competition as follows:-
 - ? Communication Approach & Self Confidence
 - ? Hand writing skills
 - Practical Orientation & use of classroom
 - Use of language & clarity
 - No marks for Local Language

GROUP DISCUSSION COMPETITION

Objectives:

1. To find out the team spirit & persuasion abilities.
2. To know communication skills in crowd & Leadership quality.
3. To use the innovation ideas, creative ability divergent and convergent thinking.
4. To know the power of retention & problem solving attitude.



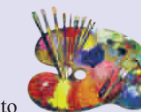
Procedures:

1. The participant is allowed to use either Hindi or English as one's medium.
2. The topic for Group Discussion will be declared at the instant hour before the contest.
3. Time allotted is 5 + 1 minute for discussion.
4. The judgment points are as follows:
 - Communication Skills
 - Content related to Topic
 - Power of comprehension, make others apprehended.

ART COMPETITION

Objectives:

1. To know the expression of ideas through Art.
2. To know the ability to use colour(s) / art in proper way to motivate students.
3. To know the aesthetic power in teaching & learning process.
4. To know the Art ability related to educational aspect of participants
5. To know the ability to convey message through non verbal teaching medium.



Procedures:

1. The participant is required to bring all initial material to prepare.
2. Time is schedules for 45 + 1 minutes.
3. The theme of the Art will be declared 1 hour before the competition.
4. The judgment of competition as follows:
 - Theme & Vision
 - Sketching
 - Painting
 - Color appropriateness

ESSAY COMPETITION

Objectives:

1. To know the power of intellectual sharpness in the individual.
2. To know the content & presentation style.
3. To know the vocabulary & grammar.
4. To know the use of innovative ideas.
5. To know the power of analysis & synthesis to the ideas.

Procedures:

1. The participant is required to complete the essay with in one hour and medium will be either Hindi or English.
2. Topic will be declared 1 hour before the competition.
3. Judgment area of competition as follows
 - Contest with deep comprehension
 - Presentation style
 - Spelling & Grammar
 - Figurative language



DRAMA COMPETITION

Objectives:

1. To know competencies of drama for motivating of student.
2. To know importance of drama as an Auto instructive devices for learning
3. To know skills of expression , and ideas and ideologies
4. To know use of gesture and posture activities



Procedures:

1. Participant is required to bring all essential requirements for drama that will be of their own
2. It will be a group activities with in his team spirit
3. Time will be 20+5 minutes
4. There should not any irregularity be entertained.
5. Drama will be of teaching and instructive based
6. There will be one act play/ play of 25 minutes only & must have a message in the plot
7. Marks may be awarded with solo type or group type will be decided by judges
8. Drama must not be a religious or special red sentimental issue that adversely affect to an educational Institutions
9. The judgment areas are as follows:-
 - Self Expression
 - Theme of the plot & background
 - Characterization
 - Use for Institutional objectives

(N.B: Drama competition will not be included for best performer cash award.)
