EVENTS AND RULES

1. Essay Writing Competition:

"An Essay is Prose composition with a focused subject of discussion" or a "long, Systematic discourse" in written form. Essay Writing will help to judge the ability of the contestant to express ideas in a logical, systematic and coherent manner. Originality of ideas, grammatical correctness and presentation style will also add value to the writing skill.

- Topics will be posted one week before the Competition on the college website. (www.ramanujan.edu.in/rce)
- Marks to be awarded on the basis of content, creativity, presentation, language & style.
- **Time for Essay Writing : 30 min.**



2. Eloquence Competition:

To communicate ideas, thoughts and feelings with clarity, proper pronunciation and intonation is an asset for any teacher. The contestant through eloquence can effectively convey by presenting varied aural stimuli to the audience. Ideational fluency, originality of thoughts and self confidence will be assessed.

The topics for eloquence are:

- India 20 years hence
- What is more important : Citizen Rights or Duties ?
- Is teaching a noble profession?
- Which came first chicken or egg?

Time for eloquence : 4+1 min.



3. Role Play / Mono Acting :

Role Playing is to perform an imaginary action within a fictitious setting. Mono Acting is enacted by a single person on stage. The contestant will get an opportunity to communicate through both verbal and non verbal modes. Gestures, facial expressions, emotions and dialogue delivery add value to a contestant's performance.

- The Participant will be given a theme at the Registration desk.
- Participant may use his / her own props and materials.
- No extra points will be given for props and materials.
- **Time for performance : 3+1 min.**



4. Poster Making Competition:

To provide opportunity to the contestants to express ideas and convey message through the medium of art/ drawing/ sketching. The creativity of the contestant will also be seen in the originality and appropriateness of the slogan.

- The participant will bring ivory sheet (A1 Size) and all required material poster making.
- Theme will be declared on the spot.
- **Time for Poster Making : 30 min.**



5. Lesson Presentation :

Each contestant is required to make the presentation with the help of ICT along with any other relevant Teaching Aid. The contestant will present, demonstrate and explain the content with the help of ICT and Teaching Aids.

- The presentation should be mailed on or before 29th Feb, 2012. USB / Pen Drives are not allowed.
- Topic can be of contestant's choice.
- LCD Projector/ OHP/ White Board will be provided.
- **Time for Presentation : 4+1 min.**



GENERAL RULES:-

- Decision of the organizing committee shall be final and binding on all participants/ contestants.
- Rules may be modified to enhance objectivity, transparency and merit.
- To be an Outstanding Pupil Teacher, the participant needs to participate and excel in maximum number of events.
- Entry is restricted to participants/contestants only. • Medium can be English or Hindi.
- Participants must carry their identity card & introduction letters from their college Principal/HOD/Dean.
- Participation can be cancelled/ disallowed in the event of any indiscipline or unethical behavior by a participant/contestant.
- Free bus transport facility from Old Faridabad will be available for participants on prior request.
- Lunch/ Refreshment will be provided by the organizers.
