The font size should be as follows: Title (14 points, Bold, Centered), Authors name (10 points, Bold, Centered), Heading & Subheading (12 points, Bold, Left Justified), Text (12 points, Normal, both sides Justified with 1" margin both sides) & Figures and tables captions (10 points, Bold, centered). Manuscript must be submitted in softcopy and printed format.

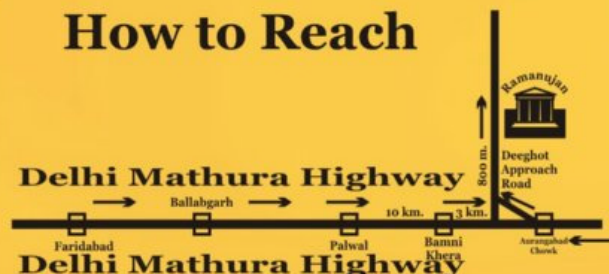
